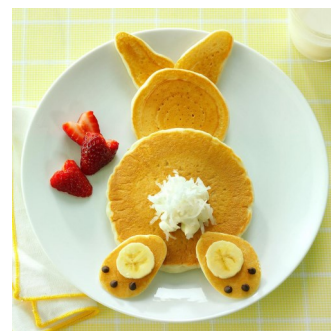
Trivia 5-0 Weekend
