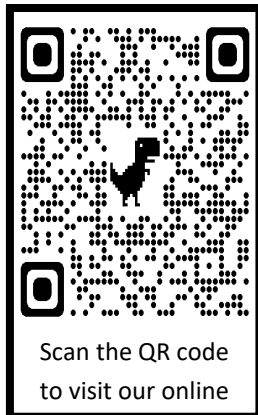

Christ in Our Home Devotionals

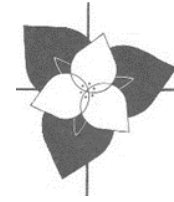

Paraments are the altar and pulpit hangings. Those used today bring together the stained glass windows. Notice how the branch continues from the west side windows across the paraments and onto the east side windows and that the window motifs are repeated in the paraments. Holy Trinity Sunday paraments are the festive color white, which symbolizes the expression of joy in the mystery of the Triune God. White is also during Easter and Christmas seasons and festival days.
