A P P L Y	<p>Mark 3:29, this week’s key, is a pretty scary declaration. No forgiveness, ever, for blaspheming against the Holy Spirit. What is blaspheming against the Holy Spirit? Why is this sin unforgiveable? How do we reconcile this with what we just read in Psalm 130 and 2nd Corinthians regarding forgiveness and grace? If God is “three in one” then is blaspheming against the Father or the Son not also blaspheming against the Holy Spirit? This reading from Mark I find very disturbing and confusing. I would love to see Trinity have a teaching session devoted to understanding the Holy Spirit. Hopefully our new pastor will be willing to lead such an endeavor.</p>
