Lenten Coins and Loose Change

Our Loose Change for April will go to Monroe House

The goal is to help residents transition from Monroe House to permanent housing, ideally within six to twelve months. Residents are accepted after an application and an interview, with highest priority given to those who pledge to follow the program and house rules. Each resident pays a program fee of \$400/month, which includes a private room, access to communal bathrooms and a communal house kitchen, and a food pantry stocked with basic food. The house is staffed by a volunteer licensed social worker, a day manager, and a night manager.

Please give generously to this worthy cause. Pour your loose coins into the collection plate on Sunday or contribute checks or bills in envelopes that clearly designate your gift. Monroe House is also looking for volunteers for a wide variety of tasks.
