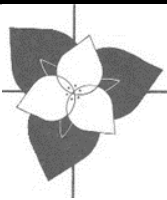

Food items also needed include, peanut butter, jelly, canned fruits and vegetables, canned meats, spaghetti sauce, pasta, cereal and popcorn.

Non-food items needed include, cleaning supplies, toilet paper, diapers, Kleenex, soap and personal hygiene items.

Operation Bootstrap acts as a food pantry for those in need and also provides assistance with rent, clothing, medical, utilities and transportation services.
