A P P L Y	In this week’s Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus heals ten lepers and after doing so sends them off to the priests at the temple so they can be declared clean. Yet after departing, only one turns and returns to Jesus, realizing he forgot to say thanks. He gives praise to God in gratitude for his now healed and hope-filled life. As he leaves again, Jesus reminds him that it is his faith that has made him well. Think about a time in your own life when you may have neglected to thank someone for the difference they made in yours? What were the circumstances? How might you “return” to give thanks to them (and to God) for all they did?
