The Mount of Olives is where Jesus ascended into Heaven is a cloud with the disciples looking up into the sky. Today it is the site of the Church of the Ascension and the Augusta Victoria Hospital operated by the Lutheran World Federation. The hospital specializes in Comprehensive Cancer Care for adults and children, Kidney Care Dialysis, Skilled Nursing and Long-term Care. The hospital also reaches the local community through outreach programs, including the Mammography and Diabetes mobile clinics. This year AVH celebrates 75 years carrying out its mission to service the Palestinian community and support the development of the Palestinian health care system, In addition to Jerusalem and the West Bank, the hospital also provides medical care in the war-torn region of Gaza.

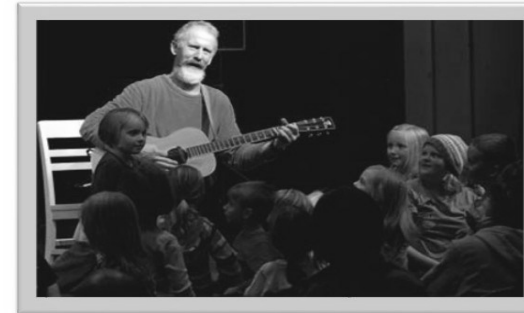
