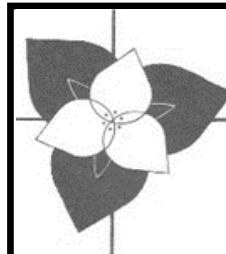
The Recipient of the Trinity Grocery Cart for the Month of August is the Salvation Army
